# ALUMNI GIFT FUNDS PILOT TO IMPROVE TEACHING-LEARNING ENVIRONMENT

The Pius XI Catholic High School Faculty and Leadership are excited to launch a three-year, multi-phased Math Pilot. This initiative, grounded in the school's Mission Statement, Strategic Plan, and instructional best practices, aims to increase student achievement in mid-to higher level math courses. Successful strategies emerging from this pilot program will be quickly shared with faculty across all areas of instruction.

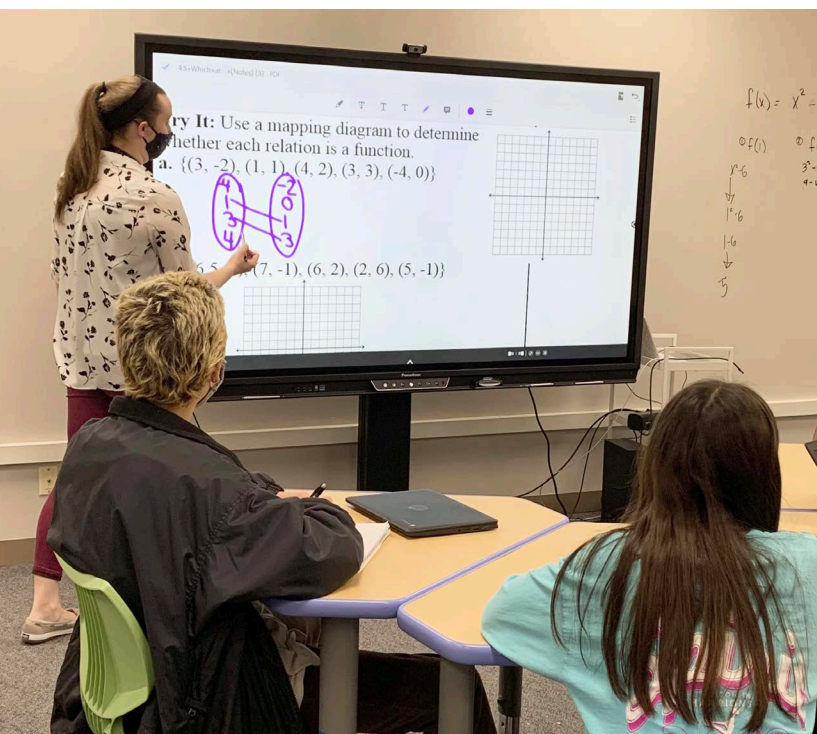
Our mission statement reads, in part: *Pius XI Catholic High School exists to prepare a diverse community of students to achieve their **unique and highest potential**.* Assuring each student becomes more of who they are uniquely called to be begins with our outstanding faculty. Teachers are committed to meeting students where they are, identifying individual strengths and needs, and employing innovative and flexible instructional strategies designed to address those needs.

The school's long-term strategic plan includes an intense focus on every student's success. The plan envisions an environment where every student meets or exceeds their reading and math proficiency targets. The vision also includes an expansion of the STEM curriculum. An alumni couple, who wish to remain anonymous, was energized by this approach to individualized learning, especially for students interested in STEM. Working closely with school leadership, the couple committed to supporting the achievement of the strategic plan's goals by starting with the most challenging, nationwide achievement gap: Math.

"The donors understand that success looks different for every student. They believe, however, that success begins with measurable goals, confidence, and engagement," said Pius XI President Jack Herbert. "If we can improve the teaching-learning environment in math, and get those improvements down to a science, what we learn will have a transformative impact on the future of the entire school."

The new Math Pilot aims to increase student achievement in mid-to higher level math courses. This multi-phase pilot includes three key initiatives. First, math faculty are provided with the support needed to implement and evaluate innovative and effective instructional practices. Transforming traditional classrooms into state-of-the-art, flexible learning environments that promote active, engaged learning is another important component. The initiative's third key attribute is the introduction of new technology, including instructional software, that encourages self-directed learning and fosters collaboration among students. Although the Math Pilot involves new teaching strategies, new classroom furniture, and new technology, the nurturing culture Pius XI has long been known for informs all pilot-related decisions.

Allison Warhus, the new Math Intervention and Support Specialist, assists the four pilot program teachers by conducting daily classroom observations and leading





weekly coaching sessions driven by student outcome data. Adjustments in classroom instructional techniques, based on these collaborative activities, are already seen as holding significant promise for impacting student achievement.

“Even experienced teachers have been able to significantly improve student engagement in a short amount of time,” said Allison. “Identifying daily objectives and planning lessons and activities around them have markedly improved class participation.”

In addition to classroom observations and group discussions, the Math Pilot faculty also evaluates the initiative using student-level data from the STAR 360 program. STAR 360 is a computer-based reading and math skills assessment that measures student growth against individual targets as well as local and national standards. The STAR 360 assessments help teachers understand each individual student’s strengths and areas for growth. These data also drive daily lesson planning as well as modification of instructional techniques based on student mastery of key concepts. Individual STAR reports are shared with students so that they can see their growth and build confidence as they plan their path forward.

One of the most exciting changes within the Math Pilot program is in the design of a math classroom which include moveable furniture and Promethean Panel technology to facilitate greater collaboration. Collaboration in the classroom is one of the most effective ways of fortifying student confidence, and grows students’ social, interpersonal, and communication skills.

Our first upgraded classroom provides mobile desks for all types of groupings based on the activity during the class. The room was prepared with a writable wall so that the teacher can see students solving problems in real time and provide immediate support. The writable wall also allows groups to collaborate. The movement of getting up to “work on the wall” supports variety in the lessons and active, engaged student participation. The initial upgraded classroom was also outfitted with a moveable Promethean ActivPanel which comes with a variety of preloaded teaching tools that appear with a touch of a button.

“The Promethean Panel has been such an amazing tool to help reach my students where they are in the lesson. I am able to make the examples clear and easy to work with. It also provides a great space for students to display their work and share with the class.” – Pilot Program teacher.

The early Math Pilot results have been so encouraging that the donors are investing in the transformation of six additional math classrooms. New mobile desks, writable walls, and Promethean ActivPanels have been ordered for the 2022-2023 school year.

Whether in math, athletics, art or any other pursuit, a disciplined approach to incremental progress leads to long-term and lasting results. We are incredibly grateful for the opportunity to have the support of those who believe that our students’ futures are worthy of their attention and significant investment.

## TERRY HARVEY



**SERVICE:** Our Catholic values are lived by treating others as we would want to be treated. We see the needs of others and reach out with compassionate hearts and hands.

In 1979, Terry Harvey interviewed for a job in maintenance at Pius XI after his mom, Gladys Harvey, a teacher and Theater Director, suggested it. He was hired on the spot, but only planned to stay for a year or two until he figured out what he would do next. It's been 42 years.

"I love this place," said Terry. "I love the kids and the people I worked with, so I just never left."

After four decades of waking up at 3:00 AM, maintaining and repairing 350,000 square feet of our home, as well as managing stage crew and building sets for countless plays, Terry will be retiring at the end of December (although he was quick to add that if we were ever short-staffed, he would be happy to come in and help).

Terry is a servant leader whose work was always behind the scenes. He has cared for and about generations of "kids", as he says, but also took great pride in making staff happy by fixing problems and meeting their needs. "I always wanted to make a good effort to make sure things worked well," he said. "No two days were ever the same and that was one thing I really liked about this work."

Over the years, Terry became a certified locksmith, learned plumbing and electrical, and refinished our gym floors. He has run the soundboard for countless school assemblies and masses, and even taught a unit on electrical safety to freshmen science students. There is not a single inch of the building he has not lovingly tended to.

And although he will spend more time with his wife and family, he won't really be too far away as he plans to continue to help with theater rentals and productions because that is just who Terry is.

**JOLYNN HENKE '07** is the co-founder and owner of Protéger Daily, a clean and conscious skincare company based in Philadelphia. The brand was born from her time caring for her mother, Dianne, who began experiencing symptoms of ALS in 2015. The company is a reflection of her love and care for her mother and their shared values of inclusivity, respect for the earth, and compassion for humanity.

In 2015 JoLynn was living in Boston working as a Client Success Manager for a software start-up focused on education in high-risk areas of medicine. The work perfectly aligned with her areas of study as she double majored in Gender and Women's Studies and Sociology at UW-Madison and earned a Master's Degree in Public Health from Boston University. "It was a job I didn't even know existed at the time," JoLynn said. "Face-to-face interactions with hospital C-suite executives, clinical leaders, OB-GYN's, labor and delivery nurses. I loved it."

Years progressed, and so did Dianne's muscle paralysis. As Dianne's need for assistance increased, JoLynn would stay with her and help with bathing and self-care rituals. They called their time together "Spa Days". They used clean beauty products that her longtime friend and now business partner Peter Clarkson would send them. "It was

so intimate, so powerful, and it opened up a door to a world I never thought I would explore," JoLynn said.

JoLynn and Peter reunited as business partners through the heartache of watching Dianne struggle. But ultimately it was their shared love of Dianne as well as Dianne's personal commitment to gardening, beekeeping and nature that brought Protéger Daily to life. Their business launched on Mother's Day of 2021.

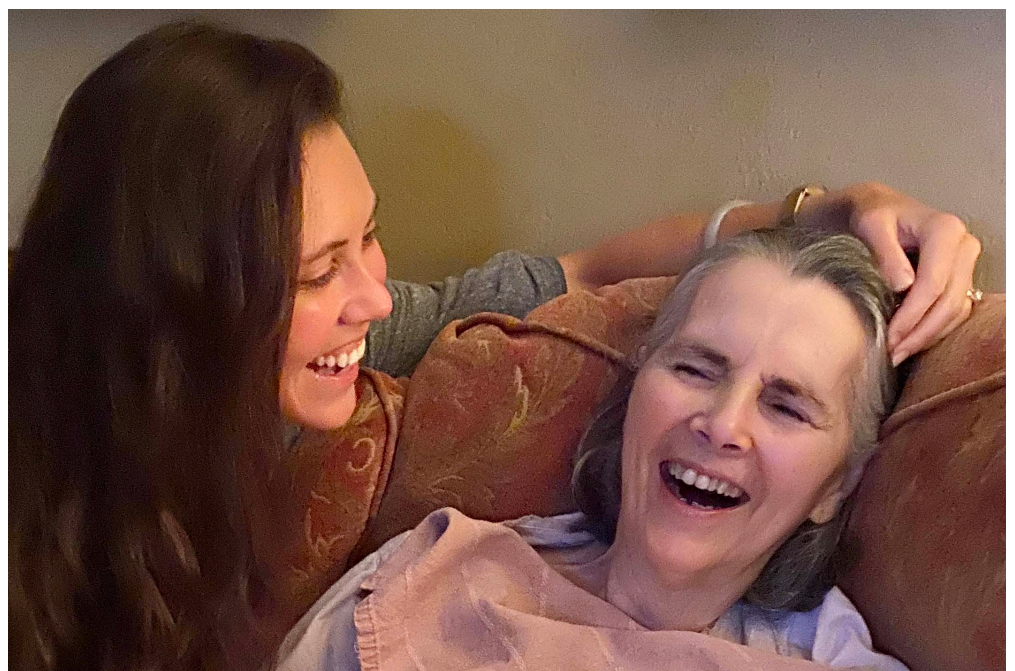
"Our product is designed for everyBODY," said JoLynn. "All genders, ages, and skin types. Everything is botanically derived, coming from the Earth. We really wanted to further her mission of doing right by our planet." Sadly, Dianne passed away in April 2021, one month before launch. But her spirit lives in the eco-friendly, gentle and nurturing products she inspired. 2% of the company's profits are donated to ALS research.

From Pius to Protéger, JoLynn shares, "Pius XI helped me become more confident in who I was as a person, living out my truth." In truth there is beauty, and beauty can be found even in the midst of life's greatest challenges.

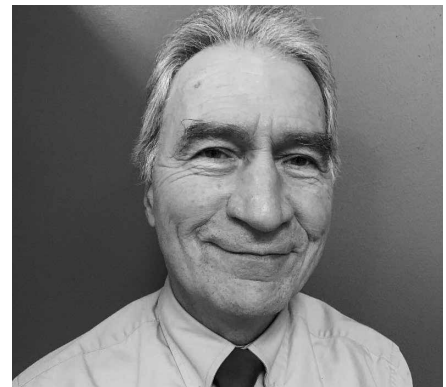

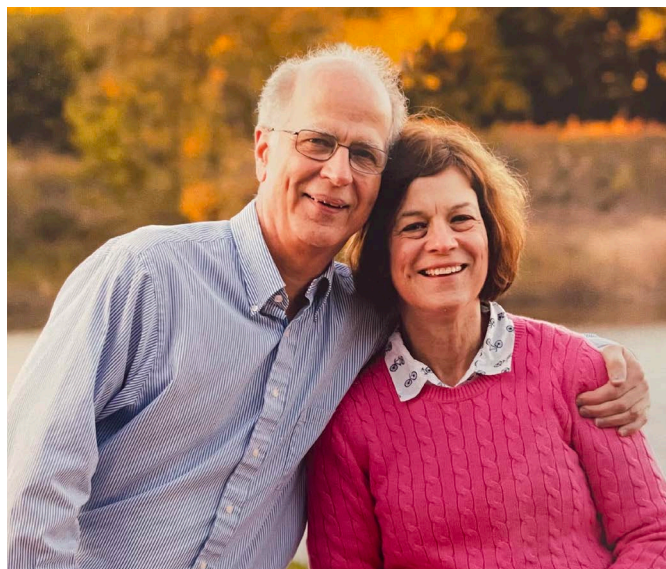
"My Dad was always of the mind that if you worked hard you could succeed, but only if you had the opportunity, and for him that opportunity for education was the GI Bill," said Patt. "Consequently, we want to give opportunities to people that might not have them."

John and Patt's best Pius XI memories are of band and orchestra, and each other, with Patt fondly recalling that John would get her a punch from Gilles during breaks of pit rehearsal. "He would give it to another girl to give it to me. I guess I made him nervous," she said.

They continued to date during college with Patt studying physical therapy at Marquette University and John studying pre-med at UWM.

John went to medical school, eventually specializing in orthopedic surgery. "Our bank accounts were pretty close to zero each time we paid my tuition bill for medical school but we were never in a position where we felt stuck because we knew that it would get better. Not everyone has that comfort of knowing that it won't always be so hard," John said.

They raised four children with John working long hours as a surgeon. One of the ways he stayed close to his kids was through coaching them in grade-school basketball



and volleyball. And one of the ways he learned to coach was by watching Joel Claassen at Pius XI. "I really just stole from him," John said with a laugh. "I wanted to teach the correct technique so I had to learn it from somewhere."

Late last year, Patt and John expressed an interest in establishing an endowed scholarship that would live on after they were gone. It was important to them that the school be able to count on a consistent source of support instead of wondering each year if there would be a scholarship.

"It is a commitment to the students and to the school that we are invested in your success," said Patt.

Future Konkell Scholars will see this story and know that they have two proud alumni on their side.

We feel most blessed to have received tremendous support through our 2021 "Ignite A Spark" Auction, as well as significant contributions from several alumni and friends for financial assistance and operational support. Our total revenue includes a one-time \$1.27M government grant. Several updates to our campus included HVAC, landscaping and parking lot re-surfacing, as well as updates in energy efficient lighting. In keeping with our Pius XI mission, we are proud to have supported more than 90% of our students through financial aid, grants and scholarships.
