Are you a sophomore or junior looking for a way to prepare for your first ACT exam?

Are you a junior or senior looking for a way to improve your ACT scores?

Preparation for the specific format of the ACT can help supplement the subject-area education of the academic school year and lead to higher scores.

Pius XI is offering a summer ACT Prep Class covering the English and Reading portions of the test, as well as the optional Writing section.

This class will focus partially on general ACT test information and strategies, with a main focus on the English, Reading, and Writing portions of the test.

Class time will include individual work, small-group work and large-group work.

In order to get the most out of our time in class together, students will be expected to do some work (approximately 30–45 minutes) on their own between class meetings.
