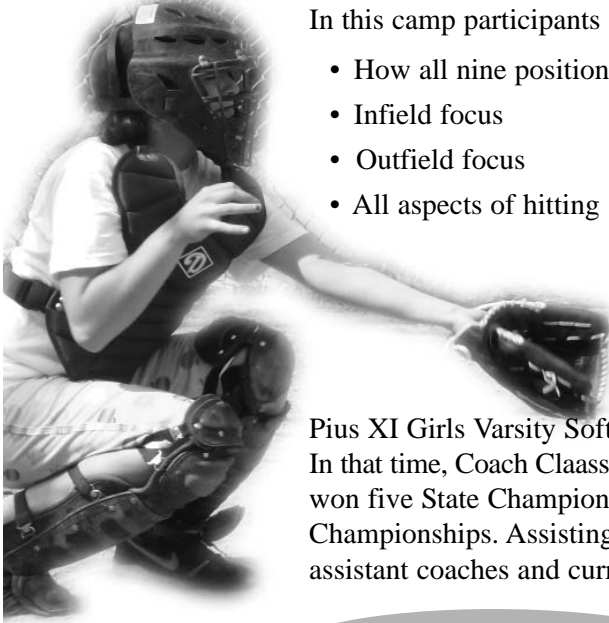

The camp boasts no individual awards, frills or thrills. The objective is for girls to learn the fundamental skills needed to play high school volleyball.

In this camp participants will learn:

- Skill training, both offensive and defensive

- Competition drills

Camp enrollment is limited and early registration is recommended to ensure your daughter a spot.

The Pius XI Girls Power Volleyball Camp will be coached by Dave Scher. Scher just completed his 22nd year as head coach at Pius XI, where he has coached eight state championship teams and 14 conference championship teams. In 2008, the girls finished as conference champions and WIAA State runners-up.

Herrick's overall basketball coaching record is 456–94.

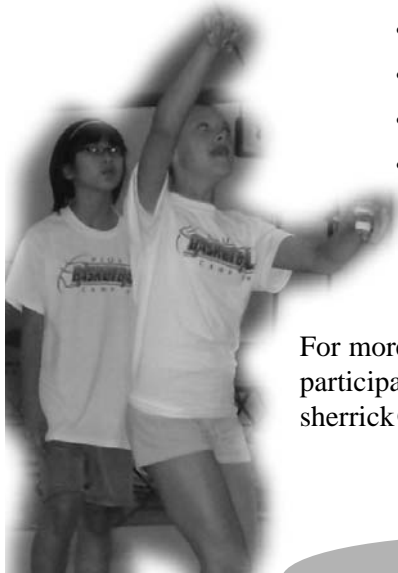

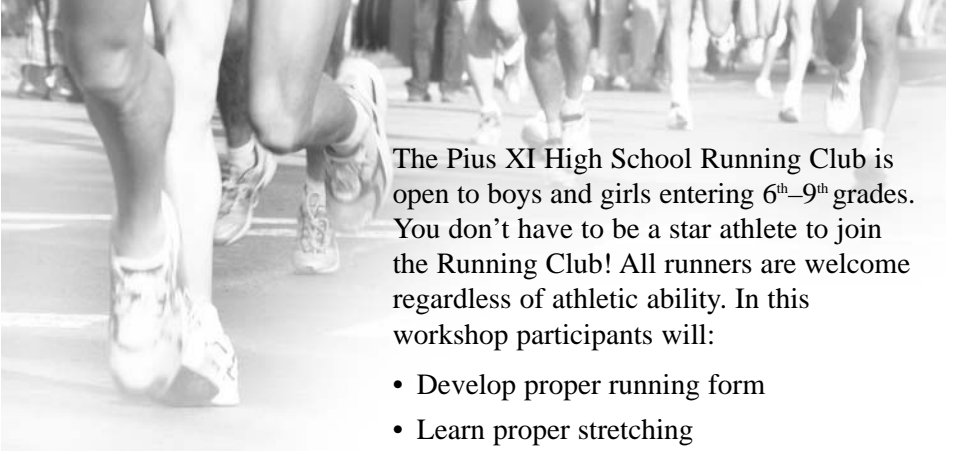

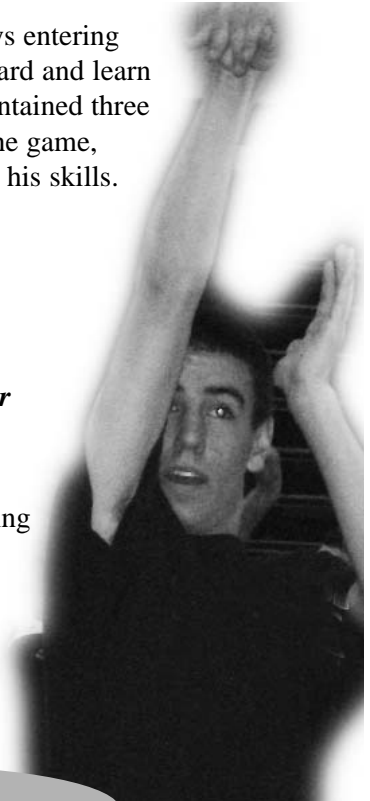
Boys **XI** Basketball

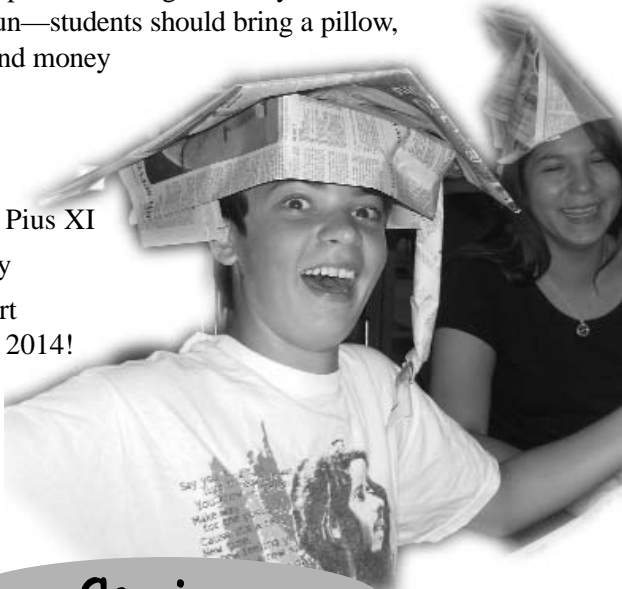

English Summer School

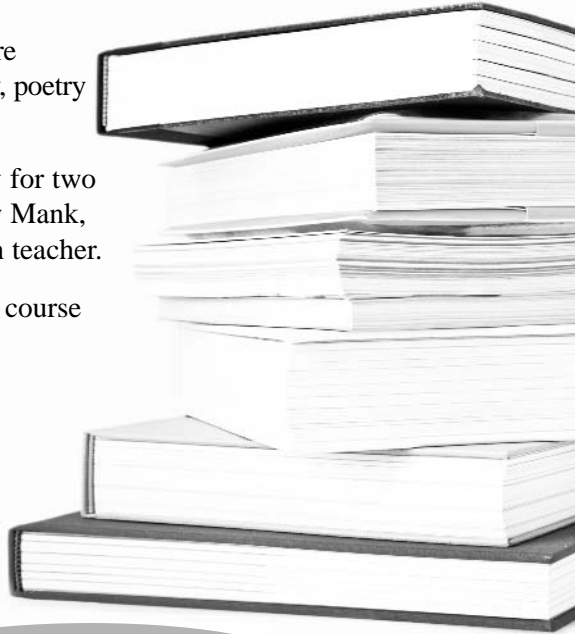
Open to current Pius XI students entering 10th grade through graduating seniors.

ACT English Prep



Are you a current sophomore or junior looking for a way to prepare for your first ACT test?

Are you a current junior or senior searching for a way to improve your score?

Open to current 10th–12th grade students, this ACT Prep class covers the English and Reading portions of the ACT test, as well as the optional Writing section. In this course, students will:

- Focus partially on general ACT test information and strategies, with a main focus on the English, Reading and Writing portions
- Work individually in addition to small- and large-group settings.
- Be expected to do some work on their own (approximately 30–45 minutes) between class meetings.

AP English

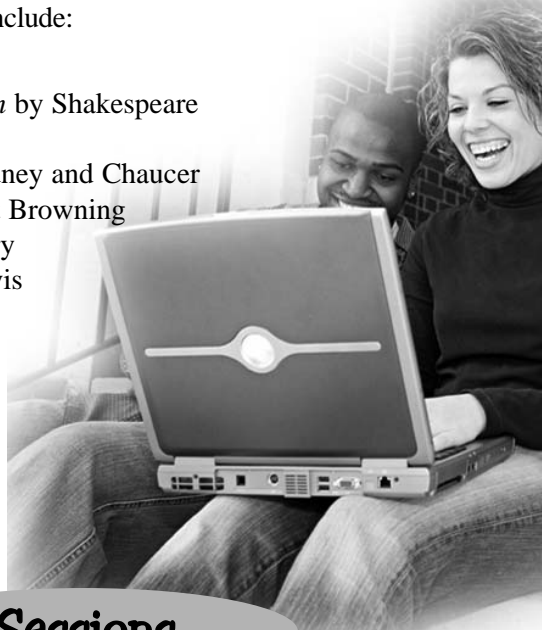
Pius XI High School is excited to offer a two-week introductory course for students accepted into the Advanced Placement English course for the 2010–2011 school year.

AP English is a challenging course, and this introductory workshop will help students prepare for the hard work and dedication required in this course.

Topics covered in this prep course include:

- Introduction to plays
- *A Midsummer Night's Dream* by Shakespeare
- Introduction to poetry
- Sonnets by Shakespeare, Sidney and Chaucer
- *Prophyria's Lover* by Robert Browning
- Introduction to the short story
- *The Necklace* by Cheryl Jarvis
- *Text 4* by Samuel Beckett
