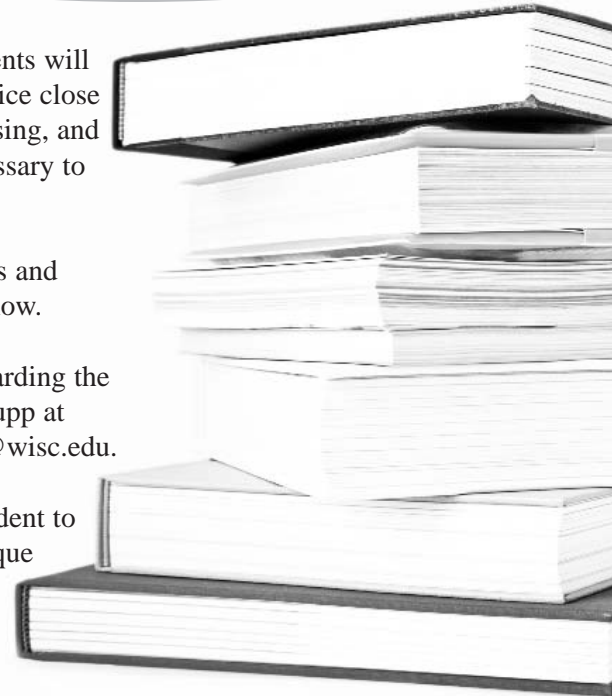
Course Overview
