The role has a primarily external focus, serving as the school's main representative within the greater Milwaukee community and the extensive alumni network. The President is responsible for all major school processes with a primary focus on providing strategic oversight and ensuring a qualified and accountable leadership team is in place to deliver excellence across all aspects of the school. The President's primary responsibility is to lead the school's strategic vision and long-range planning, with a strong emphasis on advancement and community relations to maintain the school's financial strength and reputation for excellence in Catholic education.

- As a practicing Catholic, the President serves as a model of Catholic spirituality and the school's core values.
- Promotes the spiritual health and growth of the school, recognizing the nature of our student body which consists of students of multiple faiths.
