# WHY?

Sports unite us in a shared celebration of skill, talent and ability. While athletes cannot gather and compete as they used to because of COVID, these qualities remain.

This one-day, 12-team basketball showcase was to feature some of the top talent from across the state, including several Division 1 committed players. It can no longer take place in order to mitigate the spread of COVID-19. But the mission remains just as important.

For the 2021 Popes Invitational (formerly the Hank Raymonds Classic) Presented by MacGillis Wiemer, LLC we have partnered with The Ability Center (TAC) in support of opportunity for people of all abilities for a virtual showcase. The Popes Invitational will feature videos produced and streamed by W7 Productions, highlighting the stories of athletes and opportunity, ability, talent and skill. 25% of proceeds will support The Ability Center's efforts to make Wisconsin Ave. Park accessible to people with disabilities.
